Bay View Yacht Club it's that time of year again! BVYC will again be participating in the Toledo Blade Holiday Parade on November 16, 2024 and we would love to make it our best parade year ever!

The Parade is by invitation only, and we are one of over 60+ organizations included in the annual festivities. It all started in 2013 with Sharon Kneisel's dream of dressing up and being part of the parade. Sharon created and sewed many costumes to dress up many BVYC members as Dr. Seuss Characters. That first year we passed out Dr. Seuss bookmarks, <u>erasers</u> and pencils. A few years later we began handing out age-appropriate books to children along the parade route. The generosity is a wonderful reflection of our club and a great way to give back to our community, and you should all be very proud of this!

With the popularity of the BVYC float, we've not been able to keep up with providing books for every child who wants one. It's heartbreaking to turn them away in the middle of all the festivities. Even the | Grinch can't stand to see it. This is why we need help with collecting Seuss books or monetary donations for us to purchase books. From now until November 13th, we are accepting all donations to help mark this milestone, hopefully distributing the most books ever on parade day.


