in the constitution, and also remember that all temporary pilings (dock poles) shall be detached from the dock by November 15th.

JUST A REMINDER SHRINK WRAP RULES

Shrink wrap rules: **Before** the shrinking process begins, it is the **boat owners** responsibility to see all the following conditions exist within an area of 10 feet surrounding the boat to be shrink wrapped. **OWNERS MUST MAKE SURE CONTRACTORS ARE COMPLYING WITH THESE RULES.**

A) All fuel tank vents are to be temporarily sealed with tape. (Note the 10 foot rule above).

B) A fully charged fire extinguisher, type ABC minimum UL rating 4A60BC will be in close proximity of the vessel being wrapped.

C) Minimum of one helper/observer present.

D) A ladder, scaffold, of similar platform to provide a safe, sturdy means of reaching all areas of the vessel that requires the shrinking process.

E) BVYC equipment is not to be used to comply with these conditions.

F) Tape must be removed from the adjacent boat fuel vents when the shrink wrapping is completed.

G) Shrink wrapping is to be done during the daylight hours only.

BVYC's Children's Day

During the late 1950's and 60's, Bay View generously hosted many orphans and disabled children from the Miami Children's Home and Sunshine Children's home for an annual outing.

On August 4th 1962, one hundred forty four children, fifteen caregivers, and eight nuns, came by bus for their visit to BVYC. Twenty seven member's boats were volunteered and small groups of 5 or 6 kids were brought aboard each boat for a several hour ride on the river. Afterwards, five members of the Ladies Auxiliary hosted a luncheon of hot dogs and soft drinks, and each child was given a small gift. Rollie Smith and Doc Stewart provided music on the banjo and percussion as entertainment before they boarded the busses to head home. Many other members helped as crew members and ground crew to make this a very heartwarming and fun filled event.

Unfortunately, after many successful years, several incidents involving inappropriate behavior by some of the children while on board the boats caused this annual event to be cancelled.

When an active member in good standing, with at least three years of seniority, decides he or she no longer wishes to maintain an active membership, he or she may change to a social membership by notifying the secretary or Vice Commodore in writing. He or she shall forfeit his or her seniority as well as any rebate of dues. However, if annual dues have been paid for the current year, he shall not be charged social dues for that year. He or she shall relinquish all rights of an active membership except clubhouse privileges and AYC/ILYA affiliation. They shall be exempt from all special assessments.

Any Social Member who has resigned their social membership, in good standing, and desires to reinstate their social membership, may request reinstatement in writing to the Vice Commodore. The Vice Commodore will present this or her request to the next membership meeting for approval by the membership.

Dues and effective dates will be on an annual basis.

If he or she desires to become an active member, he or she shall forfeit any rebates of social dues and his or her seniority shall begin on the date of application and he again assumes all active membership rights and obligations.

Underlined sentence to be changed to:

Should a social member in good standing, within 60 months of the date of their status change from active to social, choose to once again become an active member, the following will apply:

- A. Payment of dues:
 - The member will pay all the active member dues, including all assessments, from the date of the status change to social, to the date of the status change to social, to the date of the status change back to active, minus social membership dues paid in that period.
- B. Seniority:
 - A new seniority date will be established for the member. The original active member seniority date will be incremented by one <u>month for each month</u> of the social membership.

This membership change will be limited to once per member.
