#### What is I-LYA?

- I-LYA is an organization of 147 clubs located in OH, MI, IN, NY, PA and Ontario.
- I-LYA serves as a "watchdog" for proposed legislation that may affect boaters in the Lake Erie area.
- I-LYA represents its member clubs by sending delegates to five major U.S. boating organizations.
- I-LYA, through the Inter-Lake Yachtsmans Fund, supports training, education and Junior activities.
- I-LYA sponsors both power and sail regattas annually at Put-In-Bay for youth and adults.

The remainder of this article is dedicated to the last item. The 2014 I-LYA regatta schedule: Junior Sail Regatta, July 20 – 24; Sail Regatta, July 31 – August 3; Powerboat & Junior Powerboat Regattas, August 6 – 10.

Within BVYC I am actively promoting the Powerboat and Junior Powerboat Regattas. If you are interested in learning more about the regattas, visit **www.i-lya.org**. On the Home page there are links to each of the four regattas.

Under the **Powerboat** regatta there are links to the Schedule, Registration, Event Rules, and Committee & Contacts. Registration includes **dockage** and the **social package** for the regatta participants on your boat. Dockage is for *four nights* and runs from noon Wednesday, 8/6 to noon Sunday, 8/10. For those who register for **dockage** with I-LYA, your dock assignment will be made by I-LYA and will be communicated to you in advance of the regatta. "A" Dock is the assigned I-LYA dock. The **social package** fee includes the following: Hot Dog Roast, Beer Trailer, Steak Roast, Thursday supper (TBD) and the Rum Party. For those who want to register with the regatta, but **not** for dockage, the appropriate **social package** (Non I-LYA Dockage Participants) must be purchased. The Registration forms are now available at i-lya.org. If you are planning to attend please mail your completed registration form and check by the **deadline**, **July 4**, **2014**. Registrations that are post marked after this date will be assessed a \$25 late fee, which has been waived in recent years, but will be enforced this year. The registration fee is refundable, if your cancellation is submitted before July 20, 2014.

For those who are taking children, please also complete the Junior Powerboat registration form. I strongly encourage those with children or grandchildren to consider attending this event; review the Regatta Schedule and you will see that there are numerous children's activities.

The following documents are posted on the Fleet Captain's bulletin board on the main deck of the clubhouse: Powerboat Regatta schedule, registration form, and contest rules; Junior Powerboat registration form and competition description. On, or near, the bulletin board will be numerous photos taken at the Powerboat regattas in recent years.
