Bay View Yacht Club is celebrating a decade of participation in the Toledo Blade Holiday Parade on November 11, 2023. We need help to make 2023 our best parade yet!

The Parade is by invitation only, and we are one of over 60+ organizations included in the annual festivities. It all started in 2013 with Sharon Kneisel's dream of dressing up and being part of the parade. Sharon created and sewed many costumes to dress up many BVYC members as Dr. Seuss Characters. That first year we passed out Dr. Seuss bookmarks, erasers and pencils. A few years later we began handing out age-appropriate books to children along the parade route. Since then, each year adding more Dr. Seuss & Whoville characters, volunteers and collecting more books, primarily by donations and the hard work and personal donations of our members.

In 2019 Bay View Yacht Club handed out over 1,600 books, and in 2021 that number grew to 1,000+. In 2022, we handed out 2,250 books—bringing our total number of gifted books to over 5,000. Seeing the joy BVYC brings to these children is amazing and is very rewarding to those who participate on parade day. The generosity is a wonderful reflection of our club and a great way to give back to our community, and you should all be very proud of this!

With the popularity of the BVYC float, we've not been able to keep up with providing books for every child who wants one. It's heartbreaking to turn them away in the middle of all the festivities. Even the Grinch can't stand to see it. This is why we need help with collecting and donating books (specifically Dr. Seuss book) or monetary donations for us to purchase books. From now until November 9th, we are accepting all donations to help mark this milestone, hopefully collecting the most books ever for distributing these on parade day.




