

Bay View Yacht Club Members participated in in the Toledo Blade Holiday Parade on November 11, 2023. This was our 10th anniversary of participating in this event.

The Parade is by invitation only, and we are one of over 70 organizations included in the annual festivities and one of the only 2 parade units given the opportunity to hand anything out during the parade. Being a crowd favorite we are fortunate enough to be in the top 15 in the line-up. In 2013, we passed out Dr. Seuss bookmarks, erasers and pencils, a few years later we began handing out age-appropriate books to children along the parade route. Since then, each year we have added more Dr. Seuss & Whoville characters. In 2019 Bay View Yacht Club handed out over 1,600 books, and in 2021 that number grew to 1,000+. In 2022, we handed out 2,250 books—bringing our total number of gifted books to over 5,000. The community service is a wonderful reflection of our club and a great way to give back to our community, and all Bay View Members should all be very proud of this! There is no way of knowing if our participation in the parade brings us new members, but it certainly reflects positively on our great club!

And this year, drum roll please... Bay View Yacht Club distributed over 3,500 books. Bringing our 10 years of giving to an amazing +9,000 books. Thank you very much to all those who invested their personal time and money to make this happen. Thank you to all the parade participants, for their time and money collecting books, it is such a joy to see the kids so excited to see us in the parade!




